- Practical conversations around land, housing, surveying, settlement planning, property navigation, and reintegration
- Linkages to major D.O.O.R. projects and relevant institutional pathways supporting practical reintegration
- A structured environment for asking serious questions about living, working, investing, building, and contributing in Ghana
